

Yizhaq Makovsky – Active seafloor processes in the Levant offshore: observations and potential implications



Dr. Yizhaq Makovsky is a geophysicist, and a faculty at the Strauss Department of Marine Geosciences, University of Haifa. He graduated his BSC (1990) at Tel Aviv University, and his PHD (1997) at Stanford University. 1998 to 2007 he worked worldwide as an on-site senior consulting geophysicist with Paradigm. In 2007 he became the establishing head of the Department of Marine Geosciences (through 2010), Charney School of Marine Sciences, and now heads the Applied Marine Exploration Laboratory (AME). He is a member in an internal committee of the Israeli Academy of Science and Humanities aimed at promoting the academic infrastructure related with the gas and oil EEZ development, and is the technical manager of the Israel Mediterranean Sea Research Center.
